Roles and Responsibilities of the RDC

The RDC at The Apollo University will have a structured set of roles and responsibilities to ensure the effective promotion and management of research activities within the institution. RAC will meet quarterly (four times)in a year . These roles and responsibilities include:

1. Policy Formulation and Implementation

- Establish comprehensive research policies that align with national and institutional goals.
- Formulate guidelines for research conduct, ethical considerations, and intellectual property management.

2. Research Promotion and Facilitation

- Promote a culture of research and innovation among faculty and students.
- Identify and disseminate information about funding opportunities from various national and international agencies.
- Encourage faculty and researchers to obtain funding form various funding agencies by submitting research proposals.
- Ensure appropriate allocation of resources, including infrastructure, equipment, and financial support for research projects.

3. Collaboration and Networking

- Foster collaborations with industry, government bodies, research organizations, and other academic institutions.
- Establish research clusters and consortia to address multidisciplinary research challenges.
- Act as a bridge between researchers and funding agencies, facilitating proposal submissions and compliance with funding requirements.

4. Capacity Building and Training

- Organize workshops, seminars, and training programs to enhance the research skills of faculty and students.
- Establish mentorship programs to guide young researchers in their projects and career development.
- Maintain the Research Management System (RMS) for sharing the status of

ongoing/completed research projects, expertise, and resources

5. Research Administration

- RDC provides strategic leadership for research
- Oversee the management of research projects, ensuring timely progress and compliance with objectives.
- Implement systems for the regular monitoring and evaluation of ongoing research projects.
- Maintain detailed records of research activities and outcomes, preparing periodic reports for internal and external stakeholders.

6. Dissemination of Research Outcomes

- Encourage the publication of research findings in indexed journals and filing of patents for innovative work.
- Organize conferences, symposiums, and exhibitions to showcase the research achievements of the university.
- Develop platforms for the dissemination of research knowledge, including institutional repositories and research information systems.

7. Ethics and Integrity

- Ensure that all research activities adhere to high ethical standards, including obtaining necessary bioethical clearances.
- Promote research integrity by establishing protocols for the responsible conduct of research and addressing any instances of research misconduct.

8. Innovation and Entrepreneurship

- Facilitate the establishment of startups and spin-offs based on research outcomes.
- Provide incubation services, including mentorship, funding support, and business development for innovative projects.
- Enhance coordination among other cells/centers dealing with University-Industry Linkages, consultancy, Incubation, Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development.

• Assist researchers in managing intellectual property rights, including patents, trademarks, and copyrights.

These roles and responsibilities will ensure that the RDC at The Apollo University fosters a thriving research environment, driving innovation and excellence in line with the institution's mission and vision.
