5.10	Does the University have a continuous internal evaluation system?	<p>Yes.</p> <p>For All Programmes except Pharmaceutical Sciences, Students are evaluated for 40% as Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA). Three midterm tests are conducted for 20 marks each and the average of the best of two tests will be considered for CIA. The remaining 20 marks will be awarded for assignments, quiz, case study, class work, seminar presentation etc.</p> <p>For Pharmaceutical Sciences Programme, Students are evaluated for 25% as Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA). CIA consists of 25 marks, comprising continuous mode (10 marks for theory, 5 marks for practical) and sessional exams (15 marks for theory, 10 marks for practical). Continuous assessment includes attendance, academic activities, and student - teacher interaction. Three sessional exams are conducted per course; the best two are averaged. Theory sessional are for 30 marks and scaled to 15, while practical is for 40 marks and scaled to 10. Attendance marks are awarded based on specific percentage brackets for both theory and practical components as per PCI.</p>

The question papers have two sections.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Section A consists of 10 questions, each carries 2 marks without any choices and the Section B consists of 5 questions, each carries 8 marks with internal choice.</li> <li>○ The questions in Section A carries 2 marks each and these questions are asked to test the K1 – K3 levels of Bloom's Taxonomy and the Section B questions (2 each from each unit to be answered either A or B) will test the K4 to K6 levels of Bloom's Taxonomy.</li> <li>○ The achievement of course objectives are assessed by CO and PO mapping at the syllabus drafting level itself which will reflect in question paper also.</li> </ul> <p>The semester End Examination theory for Pharmacy is for a total of 75 marks. Section I consists of either 20 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) carrying 1 mark each or 10 Objective Type Questions carrying 2 marks each, totalling 20 marks. Section II includes 3 long answer questions, out of which 2 must be answered. Section III comprises 9 short answer questions, out of which 7 are to be answered.</p>

Each course teacher has to submit question bank in the subject he/she is teaching the subject in that semester one month prior to the examination through the Dean of the school/ Head of the department. The question paper will be set by picking the questions randomly in the O/o Controller of Examinations (CoE). After setting the question papers, senior Professors from the school/ department will scrutinize to ensure correctness and quality.</p> <p>➤ <b><u>Board of Examiners:</u></b> All the course teachers are members of the Board of Examiners under the Chairmanship of the Dean / HoD. The</p>

		<p>answer scripts are evaluated by the internal faculty members and finally the Dean / HoD will randomly check the scripts and will recommend for moderation, if needed.</p> <p>➤ <b><u>Invigilators:</u></b> Examinations are conducted by the Chief Superintendent of Examinations nominated by the CoE. All the examinations are conducted in the examination halls exclusively meant for this purpose which are provided with CCTV surveillance, Invigilators are appointed by the Chief Superintendent of examinations in a ratio of 1:30. Conduct rules are circulated to the invigilators with regard to time keeping, maintaining discipline and preventing any malpractice in the hall. In case of emergency, substitutes are allowed to replace the invigilators. Invigilators are responsible to distribute answer booklets, question papers and collection of answer scripts and hand over to the O/o CoE. 

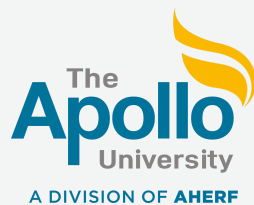
