



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

University Of Leicester, UK

and

Apollo Hospitals Group, India

It is the desire of the parties named herein that a Memorandum of Understanding ('Memorandum') be formalised based on the headings set out below:

1. Parties

1.1 University of Leicester, UK, is a Higher education Institution located in Leicester, UK, hereinafter referred to as UOL.

1.2 The Apollo Hospitals Group has its entities located across the globe and is engaged in health care delivery, education, research and innovation, with its head office at Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India, hereinafter referred to as AHG.

2. Statement of Purpose

2.1 UOL and AHG recognize that they have many interests in common and that there will be mutual benefits from collaboration and cooperation.

2.2 UOL and AHG wish to formalize and standardize the relationship between the parties in order to provide consistency, and a focal point, for the cooperation and administration of programs for collaboration and cooperation.



2.3 This Memorandum is not legally binding and provides the mechanism through which the expressed intent of the parties can be realized.

3. Objectives

In order to promote international cooperation and to foster mutual interests in education and research in the fields of medicine, data science & engineering, UOL and AHG, collectively agree to cooperate in the following activities. Concrete operational cooperation in the given frame of this agreement will be directly organized between the two partners in the same or appropriate fields of research and/or education.

- a) University academic programmes in allied health, healthcare management, and health data science, to be delivered at both the University of Leicester campus and at the Crewe Campus:
- b) Academic collaboration between University of Leicester and The Apollo University (TAU), including the development of academic progression agreements.
- c) Short Courses towards enrichment of knowledge, enhance employability and preparation for Master's degree program.
- d) Joint Research - To develop a novel world class institute of Digital Health and Precision Medicine
- e) Faculty and Student Exchange

3.1 Each of the above programs agreed upon by both parties shall be entered into a separate legal agreement as required. Prior to the commencement of each specific program or activity, the terms of its implementation shall be documented in writing, covering but not limited to intellectual property rights and financial arrangements.



3.2 The specific agreement must be formally approved by UOL or by its representative, and within the specific entity within AHG or its representative.

4. Coordination of the Memorandum

4.1 The parties to this Memorandum will, within one month from the signing of the Memorandum, each designate a key contact person who will take responsibility for the development and achievement of the Objectives of this Memorandum.

5. Terms and Conditions of this Memorandum

5.1 The term of this Memorandum shall be 2 years from the date of the last signature, on the understanding that revision or renewal may be done according to the cooperation needs.

5.2 Either party may terminate this Memorandum at any time by giving not less than six months' notice in writing, though such action will only be taken after consultation among delegates.

5.3 Each Party shall keep confidential the terms of this MOU and any information that it may acquire in relation to the other party's organisation and/or finances for the full term of the Memorandum.

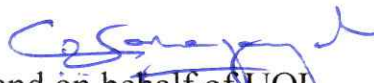
5.4 Unless agreed otherwise in writing, any intellectual property rights belonging to the parties, whether in existence at the date of this Memorandum or created during the course of it, shall belong to the respective parties.

6. Disclaimer

6.1 Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either party nor will any constraints or financial obligations be imposed by either party upon the other in carrying out this Memorandum.



6.2 The parties agree that this Memorandum is not legally binding and will act only as an interim understanding until further Agreements are reached for the separate activities identified within this Memorandum.
